Shake the mic gently to join any song in progress.

Shake the mic rhythmically during music jams to earn Performance medals.

Tilt the mic when the Star Stream symbol appears on-screen.

Tilt both mics at the same time to trigger a kiss in the Kiss party game.

Tilt both mics if you're playing in Co-op mode to get double stars in Star Stream.


Tilt the mic to extinguish the lit fuse in the Time Bomb party game.

Shake the mic to sing to the end of a song launched in Short mode.

# Jump In and Sing!

You just loaded the ultimate singing experience. Ready? Hit it!







#### Jump In

When you load *Lips*, use  $\bigcirc$  to move to **Sing!**—the first option on the main screen—and then press  $\bigcirc$  on your Xbox  $360^{\circ}$  Controller.

All the songs in your Lips library are now available to you and on your screen. Next, use  $\bigcirc$  to move to a song you want to sing, and then press  $\bigcirc$ .

From the menu choices:

- Sing!
- Add to playlist
- Rate this song
- Delete song

Use O to move to Sing! again, and then press (A.

You're now in Backstage, where you prep to sing. What do you want to sing to: The original video? An equally original party game? (Go to "Videos and Party Games" on page 8 to find out more.)

Next, decide to sing either the FULL version or the SHORT version of the song. To sing right away, go with SHORT. If you

want to see more options, check out **Song Options**. Use O to move to your choice, and then press (3).

If you selected **Song Options**, then you can make a few more choices:

- Multiplayer: Choose from Co-op or VS modes.
   Co-op is for duets. VS (or Versus) is for sing-offs.
- Voice Reduction: Reduce the recorded voice, so yours shines through.
- Audio Effects: Add pro effects to your voice.
- Noise Makers: Add rhythm instruments to your Xbox 360 Controller.
- Timing Offset: Calibrate your vocal timing.

Now grab an Xbox 360 Wireless Microphone. It's time to take to the stage and  $\dots$ 



## Sing!

Shake your motion-sensitive microphone gently until it glows. This lets you know it's synched with your *Lips* game.

Whenever you sing, follow the wave of color as it passes through the lyrics bubbles on your screen. Doing so helps you keep up with the song's lyrics (the words) as they scroll on-screen.

If your singing matches the timing of the lyrics and the pitch of the music, then the bubbles fill with color and your score increases!

Lips' dynamic scoring system calculates every facet of your singing performance—from your ability to sing a song's lyrics on key and in time to your ability to perform like a pro using vibrato and slick microphone moves.


The better you sing and move, the higher your score and the more chances you get to trigger Star Stream. The more stars you get, the higher your score soars and the brighter your star shines in the *Lips* universe!

When a mic gesture icon appears to the right of the melody bars, strike that pose to trigger Star Stream.

Go for bonus stars to get more points!


Want to belt it out? Hold the mic away from your mouth a bit, or press and hold to reduce mic volume.

### Playlists

Creating a playlist is a lot like selecting a song.

First off, there are two types of playlists:

- Instant Playlists: These are best used with single gameplay sessions, and they don't get saved.
- Named Playlists: These are best used with longterm gameplay, and they do get saved—until you delete them.

Return to **Sing!** on the main screen, and then press **A**. Now you can see the songs in your library.

Use  $\bigcirc$  to move to a song for your playlist, and then press  $\bigcirc$ .

From the menu choices:

- Sing!
- Add to playlist
- Rate this song
- Delete song

Choose Add to playlist, and then press (A).

Next, if you want to add this song to an Instant Playlist, choose Instant, and then press  $\Delta$ .

When the **New Playlist** color bar appears, press and then use your Xbox 360 virtual keyboard to type in a unique name.

When you return to your library, you can choose another song to add to your current playlist, or create an entirely new playlist.

Press to display the Playlist screen and check out your new playlist.



## Single, VS, or Co-op Play?

Got game? Lips delivers three gameplay modes:

- Single mode isn't something you just declare you and your mic have to take center stage. But be ready to share, because anyone can shake the second mic to join in, creating an instant multiplayer session.

- It takes two in Co-op mode. Team up with a friend to sing together for a combined score.
   Trigger Star Stream as a duo to double your stars and boost your Grand Rank.

# Your Xbox 360 Wireless Microphones

Lips comes with two microphones—one black and one white. You can sing into them and then some because they also function as game devices.

#### Shake to join in

Shake the microphone gently to enter the game in Jukebox mode! A friend can shake the second mic to join the game in progress.

#### Tilt to win

Move the mics during songs for extra style points! Sometimes you must gesture your mic in specific ways, such as tilting it at a key time to win a party game like Kiss or Time Bomb.

And because these mics are worthy of a megastar, you can shake them during the song (when you're not singing) and they sound like tambourines, maracas, or other rhythm instruments. They can even make sci-fi sound effects. Epic!

#### Choose your colors

The Options menu lets you, among other things, set the on-screen color for each player's mic and song bubbles.

From the main screen, use  $\bigcirc$  to move to **Options**, and then press  $\bigcirc$ . Next, move to **Color**, press  $\bigcirc$ , and then scroll through the color schemes.

Each color option appears dynamically, so you can preview it. The top color bar previews the color for Player 1, and the bottom color bar is for Player 2.

## Noise Makers: Fun with Xbox 360 Controllers

Not ready to sing? Need to rest your voice? You can still play *Lips* while others sing—just use the Noise Makers on your Xbox 360 Controller to keep the beat.

All you have to do is rhythmically press the (), (), (), (), (), (), (), (), (), (), and () buttons. Get good and you could snag the Party medal. Celebrate!

Load any set of rhythmic Noise Makers from the Song Options area—before the song starts, when you're Backstage. Want tambourines? Snapping fingers? More cowbell? Load 'em up ... and don't forget to add crowd noise with \$\mathbb{0}\$.

There's more to playing than singing: Use your controller to keep the beat.

### Videos and Party Games

Before you play, take a moment to choose what cool video or party game you want to accompany your song choice.

For most songs, you can play the Original Video, the music video created for that song.

Lips also offers you a choice of totally unique visual backdrops.

Custom Videos are your backup when a song doesn't have an Original Video option, so you still sing in stellar style.

Virtual Music Video features a computergenerated video with a club feel, super-saturated colors, and lots of moves. The more you move the mic to the beat, the more active the video becomes.

Feeling like you got the chords to toast your rivals? There are all sorts of challenges in Lips beyond the straight-up musical ones.

When you're Backstage and just about to sing, why not up the ante and load a Lips party game?

A party game adds an extra layer of challenge to your singing—in addition to your performance score. Choose from these three party games:

- Vocal Fighters
- Kiss
- Time Bomb

You can get daring with the Random option, which flips through the video and party game offerings like a slot machine wheel. Jackpot!

## Vocal Fighters

Jukebox mode plays a random selection of music. Get the party going, and then jump in and sing any time by gently shaking the mic. The longer you're in Jukebox, the brighter the glow of the *Lips* disco ball on your screen.

There are two ways to start a multiplayer party.



Make a move to **Jukebox** on the main screen, and then press **A**.

If you want to play in Faves mode, press (A).

If you want to play in Playlist mode, press and then press (A).

Faves mode plays a

continuous random sampling of your music based on your song ratings. For instance, you can set it to play all the songs you rated three or more stars. Leave it on as your party rages. Jump in any time you want to sing with a shake of the mic.

Playlist mode works similarly. Instead of selecting songs based on ratings, though, selection is based on your playlists. [If you haven't created a playlist yet, go to "Playlists" on page 4 for more.]


